To discover sacred authors' intention, must consider:

- · Conditions of their time and culture
- · Literary genres in use at that time
- Modes of feeling, speaking, and narrating at that time
- Sacred Scripture must be read and interpreted in the light of the same Spirit by whom it was written
- Study from pastoral/practical approach **BUT**
- Be especially attentive "to the content and unity of the WHOLE Scripture"
- Scripture is a UNITY by reason of the unity of God's Plan with Christ as the center

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

LITERAL SENSE: (Speaks of DEEDS)

What is the plain meaning conveyed by its grammatical construction and historical context? The literal meaning corresponds to the intention of the authors. All other SENSES of Sacred Scripture and the second seco

SPIRITUAL SENSE: Three categories

•ALLEGORICAL Sense: (Speaks to FAITH) How does this relate to JESUS?

•MORAL Sense: (Speaks to how we should live/act) How does this relate to ME?

•ANAGOGICAL Sense: (Speaks to our DESTINY) How does this relate to the FUTURE?
